COSMETIC AFTERCARE

After cosmetic materials have been placed (laminates, bondings, composite fillings, touch ups and maintenance appointments), please follow these cautionary procedures:

- 1. To maintain your restored smile, you can immediately brush vigorously or use an electric brush. Avoid abrasive type tooth pastes with pigments.
- 2. It is possible to notice speech changes; these changes may be normal and will adjust. There are some adjustments that may need to be done if accommodation does not occur within 2 weeks.
- 3. Professional cleaning 3 times per year will minimize staining and maximize longevity of the restoration.
- 4. A custom mouth guard may be required if you clench or grind you teeth. Please notify us if you believe you require a mouth guard if one has not been recommended.
- 5. Do not chew ice, hard foods, fingernails, frozen chocolate bars, pencils, etc.
- 6. Do not use your teeth as tools to open wrappers, bottles, pens, nuts or to grasp pins, screws, or paperclips.
- 7. Avoid dark lip color for 48 hours.
- 8. Avoid alcohol and dark liquids for 48 hours.
- 9. Use in moderation: coffee, tea, soy sauce, cherry colas, alcohol, or dark fruit juices, as they will shorten the life of the restorations.

Repairs for chips and/or fractures will be repaired at no charge for the first year. This does not apply to damages from sports activities, auto accidents or lack of compliance with the above instructions.
